

BULKY ITEM COLLECTION

Special pickups are available for large bulky items that cannot go into garbage containers for regular garbage collection. One \$15.00 sticker equates to two larger items (recliner, mattress, etc) and six bags or boxes. Each pick up will be one truck load or less. Anything in excess will require an additional pick up and sticker. Entire house clean outs will require a dumpster. Stickers are available in the finance office at City Hall (915 16th Avenue) or Jewel Osco (EM) and Hy-Vee (Silvis) customer service counters.

Republic Services provides bulky item collections on Wednesdays only. Items may be placed out on the **weekend prior** to the scheduled collection date. All items must be out by 6am on the scheduled date.

Please schedule online at www.eastmoline.com/bulky or contact the Maintenance Services (1200 13th Avenue) office at **309-752-1573 ext. 0** to schedule. Do not place items curbside until you have scheduled your pick up. Items shall be placed in a neatly stacked pile where your normal garbage is picked up.

GUIDELINES FOR BULKY ITEM PICK UPS

- Small items such as clothes, dishes, and toys must be kept together in a bag, box, or container not weighing more than 50lbs each.
- Carpet may be set out but must be cut into 4-foot-wide sections, rolled up and secured into bundles.
- Wood pieces with nails or staples must have them hammered down or removed.
- Lawn mowers must have all fluids drained.

*Bulky item pickups may **NOT** be used for televisions, computer equipment, appliances, used tires, household hazardous materials, asphalt, construction material (drywall) roofing materials(shingles), railroad ties, bricks, or concrete. Additionally, live bullets, explosive materials, fireworks, or other munitions will not be collected.*

ALTERNATIVES FOR UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Contact Weikert Recycling to dispose of appliances and tires at no cost.

- **Appliances / White Goods accepted:** refrigerators, stoves, water heaters, freezers, air conditioners, humidifiers, stoves, washers/dryers, dehumidifiers, ovens, garbage disposals, dishwashers, water coolers, heat pumps, chillers, furnaces, boilers, and microwave ovens (limited to 4 per calendar year)
- **Tires:** residentially generated with rims removed (limited to 10 per calendar year)
- **Ammunition:** Take live ammunition to the East Moline Police Department – 915 16th Avenue.
- **Batteries/Lightbulbs/Small Electronics:** May be taken to Batteries Plus during store hours at 300 Avenue of the Cities, East Moline. For a full list of what they accept – visit: www.batteriesplus.com/recycling
- **Used Motor Oil** – Visit www.ricwma.org/recycling/used-motor-oil for a list of places to dispose safely.
