



Important Information About your Drinking Water

Failure to Comply with a Reporting Procedure

East Moline Water Customer,

This notice is being sent to you by the City of East Moline Water Department, water system identification number 1610250.

Our water system recently failed to comply with a required reporting procedure. We test water quality parameters for pH, alkalinity, hardness and chlorine and report their results to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) every six months. When we report these results, we submit both the results and a certification of results form that indicates that we are in compliance with IEPA requirements for these water quality parameters.

For the period of July 2021- December 2021, we submitted the water quality parameter results, but failed to submit the certification of results form. Upon notification from the IEPA that we did not submit the certification of results form, we completed the form and submitted it to the IEPA on January 21, 2022, thereby returning to compliance.

There is nothing that you need to do. This is simply notification that we failed to comply with a required reporting procedure. Your water continues to meet or exceed all drinking water standards as established by the Environmental Protection Agency. You may continue drinking your water!

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
